SKATING CLUB OF HINGHAM  
MEMBERSHIP CLASSIFICATIONS

**HOME CLUB SENIOR MEMBERSHIP**

is a full membership available to all individuals who may qualify as "Eligible" skaters under the rules of the USFS. Home Club Senior Members are subject to all the rules of The Skating Club of Hingham and are eligible for all of the benefits. Home Club Senior Members in good standing of The Skating Club of Hingham are eligible for full voting privileges. The voting privileges of those Home Club Senior Members under the age of eighteen (18) who qualify to vote must be exercised by a parent or legal guardian. Any "Home Club Senior Member", who turn eighteen (18), must notify the Skating Club of Hingham, in writing, stating who will have their voting proxy.

**JUNIOR MEMBERSHIP**

is a limited membership, available to those skaters who may qualify as "Eligible" skaters under the rules of the USFS, and that, due to their age and/or skating ability and/or the safety requirements of the membership, the Board of Directors of The Skating Club of Hingham in conjunction with the Professional Staff of The Skating Club of Hingham, has determined to be of minimal skating ability. Skaters may hold a Junior Membership for a maximum of three (3) seasons or up and till the skater's thirteenth (13) birthday only (seasons run from September to September). Junior Members have walk-on privileges on Skating Club of Hingham ice, as determined by the "Rules and Regulations" of the Skating Club of Hingham. Junior Members are subject to all the rules of The Skating Club of Hingham. Junior Members in good standing of The Skating Club of Hingham are eligible for full voting privileges.

**ALUMNI/ADULT MEMBERSHIP**

is a limited membership available to previous Senior Home Club Members of the Skating Club of Hingham over the age of eighteen (18) or who have recently graduated who desire a USFS membership and limited ice privileges on The Skating Club of Hingham Ice. Alumni Members are subject to all the rules of The Skating Club of Hingham and are eligible for some of the benefits, but may not contract ice, and are not eligible for voting privileges. They have second priority on the walk-on list.

**INTRODUCTORY MEMBERSHIP**

is limited to individuals who have never been a full member or individual member, who may join only as members of a member club. They will receive a special discounted membership rate for one year only, and will be accorded all the benefits and privileges of membership. No person can be an introductory member for more than one year, even if their membership lapses. Applicant and/or parent agrees to abide by all the provisions as set forth in the bylaws of the USFS, The Skating Club of Hingham, the "Rules and Regulations" of the Skating Club of Hingham, as well as all additional rules in effect during the term of the membership. Also Introductory members do not have voting privileges .

**COLLEGIATE MEMBERSHIP**

is limited to individuals who are enrolled in college and is good for a consecutive four year period. Applicant and/or parent agrees to abide by all the provisions as set forth in the bylaws of the USFS, The Skating Club of Hingham, the "Rules and Regulations" of the Skating Club of Hingham, as well as all additional rules in effect during the term of the membership.
